This letter is issued to comply with Sections 2.103 and 90.421 of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Rules and Regulations and Chapter 8.3.3 of the NTIA Manual of Regulations and Procedures for Federal Radio Frequency Management, which provide for joint operations on non-government frequencies on a planned or scheduled basis.

For the purpose of this authorization, Whitman County, Washington includes all law enforcement and fire agencies.

Please let this letter certify that I hereby grant Whitman County permission to use the Spokane Regional Emergency Communications System. Whitman County use of the Spokane Regional Communications System will be restricted to intercommunications between any Spokane County Regional Communications System Authorized User Agencies and the Whitman County personnel for the purpose of Emergency Communications, Joint Operations, or Mutual Aid.

Whitman County personnel operating under this letter of authorization must conform in all respects both to any restriction or limitation imposed by the FCC on the principal licensee and all Spokane Regional Emergency Communications System policies and procedures.
